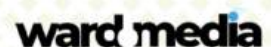

Today, Amperon is a trusted partner to power and utility companies, delivering demand, renewable generation, and price forecasts.

This empowers a single Hero Operator to achieve superhuman levels of awareness, endurance, and scale across vegetation management, fireline construction, and search-and-rescue missions.

Reclaim Metals Inc. is a clean-technology startup revolutionizing the aluminum supply chain through AI-powered optical sorting. Every year, the U.S. exports 2 million tons of scrap—a \$2.3 billion lost opportunity—due to inadequate sorting. Our patent-pending "chemical fingerprinting" makes invisible alloy signatures visible to standard optical cameras, allowing our deep-learning models to sort scrap at industrial speeds with over 90% purity. We empower domestic recyclers with a \$0.60/lb value lift, transforming low-grade waste into high-value manufacturing feedstock. By keeping these resources onshore, we strengthen American manufacturing, reduce carbon emissions by 95%, and secure a more resilient domestic economy.

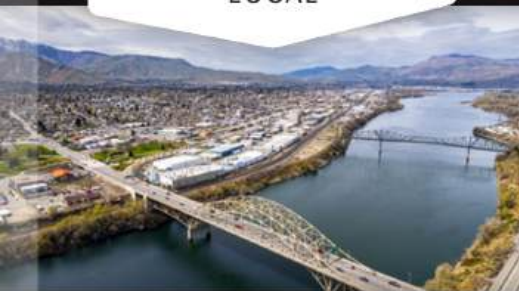
